

The application deadline for the Foresters Competitive Scholarship program is **26 February 2021!** Use the checklist below to help you stay on track.

Step 1: Check eligibility

- □ I am an eligible¹ Foresters Financial member, their spouse, child, grandchild or a person under their legal guardianship
- I have completed 40 hours of volunteer work between 1 March 2019 and 26 February 2021
- If I'm leaving school, I can provide copies of certified exam results indicating scores of B (A-levels/AS-levels), 4/C (GCSE) or equivalent. If I am at University, I have a minimum weighted average mark of 70%
- □ I am enrolling in a minimum 2-year, full-time programme at an accredited university or technical and vocational institutions in the United Kingdom in the Autumn of 2021

Step 2: Request documents

- □ Ask for an electronic academic transcript
- □ Ask for a reference letter from someone familiar with my volunteer work

Quick tip: Reference letter can't be from a family member!

Step 3: Start application

□ Visit <u>foresters.com/scholarshipUK</u> to start my online application

Quick tip: Get started as soon as possible and add your documents as you receive them.

Step 4: Tell us about yourself

- □ Provide details and dates for the volunteer work and extracurricular activities I've been most involved in
- Write 250 words or less about my experience with a volunteer project, how it helped support my community and the impact it had

Quick tip: Be sure to tell us why it was meaningful to you!

Step 5: Review and submit

My application must be complete and submitted online by 26 February 2021

Quick tip: It's a good idea to submit documents and application early, so Foresters can alert you if anything is missing from your application!
